



## **Photocopy and Copyright Policy**

The Fitchburg Public Library provides photocopiers for use by the general public. Much of the material available in the Library is protected by copyright law. In accordance with United States copyright law, reproduction of copyrighted materials may only be made for the uses of private study, scholarship, or research. Patrons alone are responsible for ensuring they comply with this law. Materials covered by copyright law include, but are not limited to:

- Books and other printed material
- Audiobooks
- Music
- Movies
- Computer games and programs

The Library has posted copyright notices at each photocopy station. Library patrons who violate copyright law may be subject to prosecution by the copyright holder.

### **Photocopies provided by the Fitchburg Public Library**

As a service, Library staff may make copies of materials for individuals unable to come to the Library due to distance, disability, or other extenuating circumstances. Library staff reserve the right to refuse this service if in their judgment the fulfillment of the request violates copyright law.

Copies provided by the Library will be in the form of a scanned image, and will be sent electronically to the requesting individual. Requests for hard copies will be fulfilled at the discretion of Library staff.
